Principal's Report – Adam Stanley

- The pandemic continues unfortunately.
 - 3 schools that surround ARE all have current cases of covid.
 - $\circ~$ ARE is hunkering down to prepare for cases at our school.
 - \circ $\,$ We have been lucky with 13 instructional days since our last case in school.
 - New staff mask regulations staff must wear their masks all the time. (Even in you are in classroom alone at 8pm)
 - September will be a regular opening as long a vaccinations effort is completed by the end of summer.
 - Ready, Set, Kindergarten (Welcome to Kindergarten) tentatively set for Friday, May 14th, but still waiting for confirmation that this can proceed.
 - Grade 7 Leaving ceremonies will be minimal, in class celebrations.

- Schools will remain open.
- Staffing issues are still a problem.
 - TTOC in short supply
 - One of our classes has had a TTOC all this year.
 - Quite a few EA's away (Sick leave or long-term absences) 7 away today
- Energy Cup is happening this month.
 - TC-1588 to come to the school.
 - Electrician looking at completing Mr. Stanley's dream of having a 50 Ft wind turbine on the roof of the school. The school could be energy sustainable.
 - There will be a live-action reenactment of the North Pacific Dead Zone. This is the giant swirling garbage patch in the middle of the Pacific Ocean consisting of 6 pack holders, plastics, bottles, and other junk that cause harm to the marine life.
 - This will be done by placing a 10 ft inflatable pool in the back of the school, adding garbage to the water, and creating the swirling effect with a gas-powered leaf blower. A lucky staff member dressed as dolphin will give a live action play-by-play on the accounts of what happens to marine life.
 - This will be live streamed during the last week of the challenge.
 - Lights are out in all hallways and select classrooms. This is resulted in a 9% reduction in electricity usage.
- Kathy contacted William Shatner to see if he would send a message to the students encouraging the student during the challenge.

 - Starting an EDI (Early Development Inventory) for Kindergarten.
