- Mrs. Gowan is now a Grade 5 & 6 teacher.
- 540 students. 18% over capacity. Every grade is completely full. Significantly waitlisted with out of catchment students.
- Following Dr. Henry's new guidelines.
  - No more cohorts. Classes can work together. Single recess.
     Can share sports equipment. Shared experiences. Sanitation once/day. Reduced cleaning. No vital oxide.
  - Mask policy still in place. Grade 4-7.
  - No visitors still.
  - Notification process has changed. No longer any blanket notifications. only contact people directly affected.
  - Fraser Health has local control over covid policies. At any time they can request changes.
  - Staff are not planning events too far in advance.
