Principal's Report – Ramin Mehrassa

- Introduced Liv Berry, our new VP. If you want to email her it's olivia.Berry@sd42.bc
- Will go by any directives from Fraser Health and the Ministry as far as illness.
- Liv introduced herself.
- Devices: the policy will be amended. Devices are not to be used outside during recess and lunch. No need for devices during instructional time (this includes recess and lunch). If parents need to contact their child, parents can call the office and a message will be passed on to the student.
- Lunch: students will pack all garbage and leftover food home.
- Request from secretaries: when picking up your child, please sign them out at the office. This helps with safety and allows the school to keep track of all the students.

- Asked on behalf of the teachers- will the classroom funds be offered again, also asked about classroom Wishlist and Selema Noon. (This should be the same as last year if the budget gets approved)
- Ramin is hoping to do another pancake breakfast after
 Christmas and requests support in this. This will be added to the November PAC meeting.
 - His hope is to to one after each break (September, January and after Spring Break)
- Welcome BBQ/ Open House is happening on Thursday. Food starts at 4:30 and 5:30-6:30 doors will open to meet the teacher.

Treasurers Report – Michelle Schultz-Lorentzen

- · Currently:
 - General Account \$ 23,126.10
 - Gaming Account \$ 19,142.13
 - Fundraising (conservative estimate) \$4,000
 - Hot lunches, treat days, Halloween Dance
 - Detailed budget will be attached
 - Several questions were asked in the chat during this time:
 - Ramin corrected that there are 32 classroom, prep and resource teachers
 - Ramin explained what happened with the Music prep. A division was gained and the portable was needed for that class. A gym prep was added in place of the music prep.
 - New water fountain has been installed
 - A question about the snack baskets. This is provided by the Student Affordability Fund (government funded). This can be used for food at school (snacks and hot lunch), pay for school supplies and field trips.

- Question was raised about playground funds. This money was raised previously and was specifically for playground equipment.
- Question about whether there is an equipment sign out for recess and lunch. No there isn't due to lack of an adult to supervise it. Chis suggested allocating some playground funds to accessible equipment.
- The school now has a full time CCW where 14 hours are dedicated to the food programs.
