CELL PHONES AND PERSONAL DEVICES

What an incredible time we are living in. The modern conveniences are amazing and help us support our children's wellbeing by providing a safe and secure feeling. Sometimes this provision can become a burden for children and research tells us that it can have a negative impact on the development of a person's social and communication abilities. As well, we can see almost a dependency on the phone developing for our children which is a little worrisome.

Here at ARE we are trying to support children and families by providing an environment free of the constant call of the cell phone. So, what does this mean? If they are brought to school, cell phones need to stay in classrooms at all times, including recess and lunch. In class, teachers have the right to establish their own parameters around these devices but as a school, the rule is.... CELL PHONES NEED TO STAY IN CLASSROOMS.
