Welcome to the Alexander Robinson Elementary School community! **ALL** parents, guardians and primary caregivers of children *registered* at Alexander Robinson Elementary are Members of the school Parent Advisory Council. The PAC is the collective voice of all parents/guardians in the school. Our purposes are as follows:

1. To advise the school principal and staff on parental views about school programs, policies and activities.
2. To communicate with parents about school programs, policies and activities through newsletters, social media, notices and meetings.
3. To assist parents in accessing the system and presenting concerns.
4. To contribute to the effectiveness of the school by promoting the involvement of parents and encouraging cooperation between the home and the school.
5. To organize activities and events to supplement school programs. In normal times, sub-committees of the PAC run the Fruit and Veggie Program, Hot Lunches, and family fun events like dances, movie nights, annual fun fair and numerous other activities. PAC fundraising pays for “extras” like performances, speakers, technical equipment, sports/playground equipment, among others. We also support parent education and access to resources.

The PAC reflects a partnership between parents and school staff which contributes to the effectiveness of the school. We work to create the best possible environment for student learning. By working together, we aim to provide better opportunities for our students, improving learning outcomes, engaging with parents and educational partners, and building our school community.
