CELL PHONES AND PERSONAL DEVICES

As convenient as cell phones and smart watches are, sometimes they can become a burden for children. Research tells us that it can have a negative impact on the development of a person's social and communication abilities. As well, we can see almost a dependency on the phone developing for our children which is a little worrisome.

Here at ARE we are trying to support children and families by providing an environment free of the constant call of the cell phone or smart watches. So, what does this mean? If they are brought to school, cell phones need to always stay in classrooms, including recess and lunch. In class, teachers have the right to establish their own parameters around these devices but as a school, the rule is.... CELL PHONES NEED TO STAY IN CLASSROOMS.
