- Principal's Report
 - Ramin introduced Rob Sheridan, ARE's new VP
 - Reminder of No Devices Policy
 - The ministry has mandated this
 - 2 Choices for students:
 - Keep their phones in their backpacks
 - Or teachers keep the phones locked up and hand back at the end of the day
 - There are exceptions to the rule (mainly for health reasons)

 - This must be locked outside (not inside)
