League Standings Tiebreaker Rules for Volleyball and Basketball.
1.) Any ties in the standings between two teams will be broken at the end of the season based on the head to head results between the teams. If the teams did not play each other, the tie will be broken by their records against teams finishing ahead of them. If this does not break the tie then the tie will be broken by a random draw of the teams involved in the tie.
2.) If there is a tie between 3 or more teams the records between the teams will be considered first. If a team or teams has a better record in the games they have played among themselves they will be placed ahead of a team with a worse record even if that team has beaten one of the teams ahead of them. This is possible if there is a 4 way tie or 5 way tie. Once the teams are sorted according to their records among themselves any ties remaining among them should be sorted according to their head to head records. If there is a curricular tie of 3 or more teams remaining in this situation their record against teams finishing ahead of them will be considered. If one of the teams has beaten a team ahead of them and the other hasn't they will be placed ahead of the team they tied with.
3.) If there is a 3 way tie or more where the record among the teams is the same and the tie is circular where 1 beat 2,2 beat 3 and 3 beat 1, their records against teams finishing ahead of them will be considered first. If one has beaten a team ahead of them that team will be placed ahead of the others. If none of them has beaten a team ahead of them the tie will be broken by a random draw of the teams involved in the tie.
