- 3 seconds in the key (it's more like 5 seconds in the key)
- Man to Man defense, not zone
- Travelling (obvious steps not sliding on the floor)
- Double dribbling

FAIR PLAY CODE FOR COACHES

- 1. I will be reasonable when scheduling games and practices, remembering that young athletes have other interests and obligations.
- 2. I will teach my athletes to play fairly and to respect the rules, officials, and opponents.
- 3. I will ensure that all athletes get equal instruction, support and playing time.
- 4. I will not ridicule or yell at my athletes for making mistakes or for performing poorly. I will remember that children play to have fun and must be encouraged to have confidence in themselves.
- 5. I will make sure that equipment and facilities are safe and match the athlete's ages and abilities.
- 6. I will remember that children need a coach they can respect. I will be generous with praise and set a good example.
- 7. I will obtain proper training and continue to upgrade my coaching skills.
- 8. I will remember that winning is not everything that encouraging my players to have fun, helping them to improve their skills, and encouraging them to do their best are my main job as an elementary school coach.
