School Responsibilities

- For the primary race days, only SD42 employees will be permitted in the finish line area **and they MUST be wearing a high visibility vest**. Race officials cannot provide vests so please make sure to bring extras from your school.
- Extra large and large schools must provide a **minimum of 2 spotters each day**.
- Medium and small schools must provide a **minimum of 1 spotter each day**.
- All spotters must be an adult or mature grade 11 or 12 student.
- **Spotter's need to report to the announcer's tent at 3:00pm**. If you have two spotters who will be trading off, please make sure to send both volunteers to the announcer's tent.

Each spotter must remain in their designated location **for all races**, so it is recommended that they bring a chair and an umbrella (on the rainy days). Please make sure you have your designated volunteer prior to race day so they can come prepared.

This event cannot happen without volunteers, so it is imperative that every school contributes to help make this event safe and successful.
