Regular Student Transportation 2017/18

At its regular public meeting on Wednesday, March 8, 2017, the Maple Ridge – Pitt Meadows Board of Education approved Regular Student Transportation services for 2017/18..

Eligibility Criteria

The eligibility criteria for 2017/18 are as follows:

PRIMARY STUDENTS (Grades K-3) and their siblings attending the same school who live **farther than 4 kilometers** from their catchment area school.

ALL OTHER STUDENTS (Grades 4-12) who live **farther than 4.8 kilometers** from their catchment area school.

The Board, at its discretion, may provide bus service for ineligible students for a fee of \$315/child/year. If there are available spaces on an existing bus route the available spaces will be allocated to courtesy riders in the following priority order:

- 1. Distance from school on the basis that students who live farthest from the catchment school will have the greater priority;
- 2. The age of the student on the basis that younger students will have the greater priority;
- 3. Catchment on the basis that in catchment students will have first priority, followed by out of catchment students and followed by out of district students.

Please note that International students (non-resident) are considered courtesy riders. Applications must be made through the International Education Department 604.466.6555.

The following schools may receive regular school bus service: Highland Park Elementary; Webster's Corners Elementary; Whonnock Elementary; Garibaldi Secondary; and Pitt Meadows Secondary.
