B. Rationale						
parents ar and staff k creating n redesigne	ntain Elementary has been for many years a small- to medium-sized school. Now that BME is at about 300 students, staff, and the older students report that what is missed is "the smaller school feel," whereby older students knew younger students knew almost every student's name. The staff aspire to regain the community and family atmosphere of the school by nulti-age groups to meet twice a month around themes related to Social and Emotional Learning (SEL) and the new d curriculum. With the MDI data, staff noted much higher numbers in the category of low self-regulation compared to the strict average, high levels of anxiety, and high numbers of absences of sadness.					
C. Action Plan (List specific actions, school level and district level resources or structures used)						
Staff will meet to create eight Wolf Packs (classes of 36 to 37 students) with two staff members per Wolf Pack. Wolf Pack Planning Committee will meet monthly to review and create lessons for the Wolf Pack sessions centred around SEL, hands-on learning, and the redesigned curriculum. The School Growth Plan budget will be utilized to fund materials and supplies for the Wolf Packs. The Feb. 13th Pro-D day will be allotted for planning and assessing the Wolf Packs.
