Principal's Message

I would also like to remind families of the message that I included in last month's newsletter as there have been rumours that students are being "locked out" at lunch time. This was the message communicated last month:

"In anticipation of inclement weather we have been hosting Lunch Clubs in the Library that occur during outside time. Students have the opportunity to play outside or participate in either Lego Club on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays, or Board Games Club on Tuesdays and Thursdays. On occasion we may open the gym for drop in Basketball and Floor Hockey. All students then return to their classrooms during eating time."

If students are outside and need to use the washroom, they need to simply ask the lunch hour supervisors to be let in the building. Once students make the choice to either play outside or participate in a Lunch Club, they should remain there to avoid wandering un-supervised in the hallways.

POWER OUTAGE BEFORE SCHOOL STARTS

In cases where building conditions prevent instruction but otherwise pose no safety concerns, the school district will try to keep the school open for students, but will ask parents/guardians to make alternate arrangements for their children where possible and return them to school once power is restored.

In cases where building conditions prevent instruction and also raise safety concerns, the superintendent will request that the school be closed.

The decision to close schools is made in a timely manner as circumstances allow. Details and updates will be:

POWER OUTAGES WHILE SCHOOL IS IN SESSION

In cases where building conditions prevent instruction but otherwise pose no safety concerns, the school district will keep the school open for students until the end of the school day.

In cases where building conditions prevent instruction and also raise safety concerns, the superintendent may authorize early dismissal, depending on the time of the day the outage occurs. The school will contact parents directly. Details will also be posted to:

WINTER WEATHER

KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION FOR SEPTEMBER 2019

The **Sibling Phase of Kindergarten Registration will begin January 21st and end January 25th**. This is open for siblings of students already attending the desired elementary school. Your child must be 5 years old on or before December 31/19.

Please remember to bring in your documents (birth certificate, care card, proof of address, etc.) as soon as you have received the email requesting this.

Choice Registration (for all students who wish to participate in any one of SD42's unique program offerings, ie Environmental School Project, French Immersion, or Montessori) will be from February 1st until February 4th.

General Registration (all new students to English Kindergarten) will be from February 12th until February 19th.

Late Registration (for parents who missed previous registration periods) will be from February 27th until June 26th.

GRADE 7 PARENT INFORMATION

Registration for grade 8 for the 2019/20 school year will be done on the parent portal. The portal will open February 5, 2019 at 12:00 noon and will close 11:59 pm on February 20, 2019. You MUST have a portal account set up with your child

linked to your account, before you can register.

If you haven't done this, please be sure to pick up the linking letter from the school office. Please refer to the district website for the policy on secondary enrolment priorities: http://www1.sd42.ca/student-registration
Parents who miss the February 20th online deadline must complete a paper registration form at their catchment SECONDARY school.

Parents will be notified after Spring Break of their child's high school placement.
