#### **Cell Phones**

While the School Code of Conduct provides important information regarding a number of areas, I want to draw your attention specifically to the section titled, <u>Personal Digital Devices</u> (aka cell phones):

The Ministry of Education and Child Care has amended the *Provincial Standards for Codes of Conduct Order*, effective July 1, 2024. As such, the following restrictions on personal digital devices (defined as any personal electronic device that can be used to communicate or to access the internet such as a cell phone or tablet) are now in place at Edith McDermott Elementary School.


- Students are not allowed to access or use a personal digital device during hours of instruction, at EME that is 8:30am-2:20pm Monday-Friday, unless explicitly given permission by a teacher or administrator.
- Students may use a school district provided personal digital device for instructional purposes an/or digital literacy, appropriate to their age and developmental stage, when authorized by a teacher or administrator.
- Students may be given explicit permission by a teacher or administrator to use a personal digital device for accessibility and/or accommodation needs, medical and/or health needs, and/or in order to provide equity to support learning outcomes.
- Students who possess a personal digital device at school must keep it stored out of sight at all times (not on their person) or submit it to their teacher or to the Main Office for storage during instructional hours.

At EME, we recognize the impact unsupervised access to technology can have on childhood brain development, mental health, social development, and we value the importance of focus on learning during instructional hours. We appreciate your cooperation in ensuring your child's education is not negatively impacted by the use of personal digital devices.
