Fairview StrongStart: Safe Restart Plan

Due to the strict Covid-19 protocols in place, we will not be allowing drop in visits to our StrongStart Programs. Preregistration is required for each session.

Our Indoor sessions are open to a maximum of 5 families (one adult and up to 3 children per family) and our outdoor sessions are open to a maximum of 10 families.

Sign up will be open Wednesday's at 9:00am for the following week

- 1. Your name and phone number
- 2. The name and age of each child attending
- 3. Which day you are requesting

A confirmation email will be sent to you after you have requested your session.

INDOOR DAY PROCEDURES:

- Upon arrival, each family will wait at one of the five designated marked areas located at the north entrance door near the front of the staff parking lot. Please note that adults are not permitted access through the main school doors so please arrive on time.
- I will greet you at the beginning of each session to complete a health assessment as well as to take attendance. The daily health assessment can be found at: https://www.sd42.ca/assets/media/Daily-Health-Assessment-Checklist-Updated.pdf
- Each person will sanitize their hands and adults will put on their face masks before we enter the building (while being mindful of social distancing). We will then walk to our classroom where you will be directed to your family's personal play space. Each play space will have a variety of materials that you would usually find in a typical StrongStart classroom. Masks may be removed once we are in the classroom if social distancing can be maintained.
- Families will not be allowed to move between play areas
- After free play, we will have a physically distanced circle time
- A light pre-packaged snack will be given to each child at the end of each session.

OUTDOOR DAY PROCEDURES:

- Parents will meet at our predetermined location within our community where I will complete a health assessment and attendance.
- Upon arrival, everyone will be asked to sanitize their hands. (Hand sanitizer will be provided)
- Outdoor days will vary depending on the location and they are rain or shine so please dress for the weather.
- I recommend that families bring a blanket or a chair for days that sitting on the ground is not possible.
- A light pre-packaged snack will be given to each child at the end of each session.

Please note that masks are mandatory for adults while inside the classroom so please be sure to bring one with you as they will not be provided.
