#### Dear Families:

I hope everyone is feeling refreshed after a break and off to a positive second half of the school year. This month's newsletter contains important information about upcoming events, and registration details for Late French Immersion and Kindergarten as well as for Grade 8.

I would also like to congratulate all the performers, staff, and volunteers who made the school's December primary musical "On with the Show" such a huge success. These productions add a great deal of energy and excitement to our school and highlight our unique elementary Fine Arts programming.

As we begin this second term, we focus on those skills we need to teach and learn over the next two months. Students need to review the goal they made for this term and stay focused to move ahead. Before we know, we will be having our  $2^{\rm nd}$  term conferences on March  $5^{\rm th}$  and  $6^{\rm th}$ . Time flies as that is only in 2 months.

Our School Growth Plan goals are with Literacy and Social Emotional Learning. Our literacy goal is for students to improve their reading strategies with nonfiction books. Our Social Emotional Learning goal is to evaluate what our students need in the areas of self-awareness, self-management, self-awareness, relationship skills and responsible decision-making. Both these are long term goals.

You can help by ensuring your child is reading daily for 10 to 15 minutes at home. Practice helps with fluency and skill development. Students who read 4 to 5 times per day are more likely to increase their reading skills. It is that old adage of "practice makes perfect."

### Requests for Student Transfers for Grades 1 - 7

School District No. 42 allows parents and students to attend a school other than their "catchment" or "neighbourhood" school, provided

there is space available at the school of choice. Parents who wish to have their children in grades 1 to 7 transfer to another school for <u>September</u> must do the following.

Obtain a STUDENT TRANSFER REQUEST FORM from their current school, complete the transfer form including signature and have the current principal sign and date it. Current school retains the Student Transfer Request Form. The forms will be available from the office starting after Spring Break.

#### The Redesigned Curriculum at Golden Ears Elementary

#### What is the role of critical and reflective thinking in the development of students?

Critical and reflective thinking is a significant Core Competency that plays an essential role in the development of a child's reasoning skills across all subject areas from kindergarten to Grade 12. When a student analyzes a situation from different perspectives and identities, it widens their own experience and encourages them to question and investigate further. Teachers facilitate students as they develop their critical thinking skills to evolve and substantiate their ideas and are encouraged to act on feedback received by their teachers and peers to adjust and refine their thinking. These skills enable students to form conclusions that reflect research, experimentation, thoughtful discussions, and personal reflection. Critical thinking skills also play an integral part in the social, emotional development of a child as it encourages self-awareness and responsible decision-making.

Core Competencies: What are they and why are they in the new curriculum?

The new curriculum centres around the following three core competency areas: communication, personal and social, thinking. They are sets of intellectual, personal, and social and emotional proficiencies that all students need to develop in order to engage in deep learning and life-long learning. Competencies are evident in every area of learning and in every grade, and come into play when students become actively engaged in their learning. During the school year, students will have an opportunity to self-assess their proficiencies in these core competencies.


