School Supplies for 2022-2023

In preparation for next year, we are reviewing our process for purchasing school supplies. Our goal is to keep the cost and time dedicated to school supplies at a minimum for parents while ensuring teachers and students have the needed supplies for the year. School supplies will be purchased as follows:

- **Incoming kindergarten:** will continue with past practice of paying a fee for school supplies and the school purchasing the supplies.
- **Grades 1-3:** will be piloting a new process where the school will bulk-order school supplies and parents will be asked to pay a school supply fee.
- **Grades 4-7:** will continue with past practice of either purchasing their own supplies from a provided list or ordering supplies through Creative Packs.
