 was in the previous year. Donations from parents are welcome and appreciated. There is one
 more school added to the list for being served universal hot lunches; total number of 6 schools
 within the district.
- Qualification to get into the universal hot lunch program depends on trackable data from schools, for example, the number of hot lunches coming from the salvation army and the number of students participating during the breakfast program.
- Relief teachers district has hired relief teachers this year to ensure there aren't shortages of teachers filling in classes. They recently completed the district intensive training program.
