- 3. Finances
 - a. Recently purchased earthquake supplies and clothing racks for the Community Free Store
 - b. Account balances:
 - i. General \$31,687.33

- ii. Gaming Account \$18,751.49
- iii. Term Deposit \$25,000.00
- iv. Term Deposit \$50,000.00
- c. Field Trip funds PAC is providing up to \$200 per teacher from the Gaming Grant for use towards field trip costs
 - i. Teachers need to submit requests by March 1
 - ii. Have received nine requests to date
 - iii. Funds can be used towards transportation, subsidize admission fees, etc.
 - iv. Pilot to determine how well this system works for teachers and PAC to utilize the Gaming Grant funds
- d. Gaming Grant applications will be changing starting next year to be associated with a Business PAC will seek more information and clarification
- e. Square Payments Transactions due to a change in Square Payment's rules PAC is halting use of Square to process debit/credit transactions at events until further information from DPAC
 - i. Effectively immediately concession sales at events will be CASH only
- f. Grade 7 Yearbooks PAC had budgeted \$800 for yearbooks based on the 2023/24 school year but it has been flagged that does not cover the full cost
 - i. Moved/Seconded
 THAT the Yearbook budget for 2024/25 be increased from \$800 to \$1500
