LITERARY STUDIES 11

ALLOWS STUDENTS TO DELVE DEEPLY INTO LITERATURE. STUDENTS CAN EXPLORE SPECIFIC
THEMES, PERIODS, AUTHORS, OR AREAS OF THE WORLD THROUGH LITERARY WORKS (FICTION
AND NON-FICTION) IN A VARIETY OF MEDIA.

CREATIVE WRITING 11

CREATIVE WRITING 11 IS DESIGNED FOR STUDENTS WHO ARE INTERESTED IN DEVELOPING
CONFIDENCE AND REFINING THEIR WRITING SKILLS THROUGH SELF-EXPRESSION FOR VARIOUS
CREATIVE PURPOSES. THE COURSE PROVIDES STUDENTS WITH IN-DEPTH OPPORTUNITIES TO
EXPLORE PERSONAL AND CULTURAL IDENTITIES, MEMORIES, AND STORIES IN A WIDE RANGE OF
GENRES.

• IS DESIGNED TO SUPPORT STUDENTS AS THEY REFINE, CLARIFY, AND ADJUST THEIR WRITTEN COMMUNICATION THROUGH PRACTICE AND REVISION. STUDENTS WILL READ AND STUDY COMPOSITIONS BY OTHER WRITERS AND BE EXPOSED TO A VARIETY OF STYLES AS MODELS FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF THEIR WRITING.

SCIENCE 11 OPTIONS...

LIFE SCIENCE 11 / IB BIOLOGY

THIS COURSE IS INTENDED FOR STUDENTS WHO ARE INTERESTED IN STUDYING LIVING THINGS FROM THE MICROSCOPIC LEVEL
 (VIRUSES) TO THE MORE ADVANCED LEVEL OF ORGANISMS (PLANTS & ANIMALS). THE COURSE CONSISTS OF THE FOLLOWING
 CONCEPTUAL THEMES: THE DIVERSITY AND UNIFYING CHARACTERISTICS OF LIVING THINGS AND THE PROCESS BY WHICH LIVING
 THINGS ADAPT TO A CHANGING ENVIRONMENT OVER TIME.

CHEMISTRY 11 / IB CHEMISTRY

 STUDY OF MATTER (ORGANIC/INORGANIC CHEMISTRY, ANALYTICAL PROCESSES, REACTIONS, STOICHIOMETRIC CALCULATIONS, GREEN CHEMISTRY...)

PHYSICS 11

THE COURSE FOCUSES ON THE STUDY OF MOTION, WITH EXPERIMENTS THAT CONFIRM MATHEMATICAL FORMULAS FOR
ACCELERATION, ENERGY, FORCES AND LIGHT. ONLINE SIMULATIONS AND VIDEOS ARE USED TO HELP STUDENTS GAIN A COMPLETE
CONCEPTUAL UNDERSTANDING OF HOW THE NATURAL WORLD WORKS.

ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE 11

 THE STUDY OF LOCAL ECOSYSTEMS. IT CONSISTS OF FOUR CORE UNITS: DIVERSITY, PROCESSES AND CHANGES, SUSTAINABILITY, AND CONSERVATION/RESTORATION. THIS COURSE MAY OFFER OPPORTUNITIES TO CONDUCT FIELD WORK IN AN OUTDOOR SETTING.

SCIENCE FOR CITIZENS 11

- EVIDENCE BASED DECISION MAKING, PERSONAL AND PUBLIC HEALTH CONSDIERATIONS, IMPACTS OF TECHNOLOGY, SCIENTIFIC INNOVATIONS ...)
- Not considered for STEM programs direct to university


