

#### What is MYP?

- The Middle Years Programme (MYP) is an inclusive program for all students in grades 8-10 that focuses on understanding & skills.
- ❖ Teachers use the redesigned BC curriculum along with MYP international assessment standards in an inquiry based framework.



- External auditors provide evaluation and feedback to ensure alignment with IB World standards
- Students have the choice in Grade 11 and 12 to continue and complete an IB Diploma Programme (DP) or to graduate with a BC provincial diploma

#### Benefits of MYP for students

- Standards based report card with strength based descriptive language
- Global connections each unit links learning to a real world context and emphasizes learning through inquiry
- Culminates with Personal Project a self-directed student inquiry project in Grade 10
- Prepares students for the IB Diploma Programme Programme (Grades 11-12)
