SCHOOL DISTRICT NEWS...

Kindergarten Registration:

The Maple Ridge - Pitt Meadows School District (SD42) welcomes you and your child to our education system. We are proud to be one of BC's most innovative school districts and make it our mission to ensure that all our learners feel valued and reach their full potential. You are welcome to drop by any school office to pick up a Kindergarten Registration brochure to walk you through the steps, however the registration guidelines are outlined below as well.



Please take note of the following dates: General Registration (Feb 1-7) and Late Registration (Feb 22-July 38) Open Registration (Aug 21).

Registration Process -

Registering your child for kindergarten is a big step, but it doesn't have to be a difficult one. With our easy online registration process, you can register your child from the comfort of your own home.

Review the registration steps below to ensure you are ready for the big day. Complete steps 1-4 **before registration** to save time.

STEP 1: OPEN A PARENT PORTAL ACCOUNT

You <u>must</u> open an *SD42 Parent Portal* account to access registration. If possible, complete this step well before registration day at <u>http://parents.sd42.ca</u>

STEP 2: FIND YOUR REGISTRATION DATE

Review our registration categories (SIBLING, CHOICE, GENERAL) to find your registration period.

STEP 3: REVIEW OUR REGISTRATION FORM

Review a copy of our online registration form before registration day at <u>http://parents.sd42.ca</u>.

STEP 4: REVIEW ACCEPTANCE CRITERIA

The order in which we place our new kindergarteners is determined by our *Acceptance Criteria*. Review these below.

STEP 5: REGISTER

Register your child at http://parents.sd42.ca

STEP 6: PROVIDE SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS

Once you receive email notification of your child's tentative placement, you <u>must</u> bring supporting documents to that school. See Supporting Documents section below

Registration opens at noon on the first day of each registration period and closes at midnight of that registration period's last day. You will be advised of your child's tentative placement via email asking you to bring supporting documents to the school.

Acceptance Criteria -

- 1. Siblings of students already attending desired elementary school currently in K-6;
- 2. IN catchment (proof of residence required)
- 3. IN catchment daycare (proof of daycare in catchment required)
- 4. OUT of catchment without siblings
- 5. OUT of district

Supporting Documents -

All students registering for kindergarten must be 5 years old on or before December 31, 2023. Parents must provide ONE of the following documents for Proof of Age: Birth Certificate, Passport, Immigration documents, Nexus Pass or BC Service Card for their child. Every parent registering a child must also show proof of BC residency with TWO of the following: BC Driver's License, BC Identification, Municipal Tax or Utility bill, Mortgage or Rental Lease documents for themselves.

If you miss your deadline to provide supporting documentation, your child's tentative school assignment will be **cancelled** and you will have to re-apply.

PARKING LOT REMINDER

To all families of Hammond, and a reminder to those families using the parking lot at the end of the day, if everyone follows our procedures and is patient for 10 minutes, things will go smoothly and safely. It is with cooperation, patience, kindness and respect for others and following a few simple guidelines that we can minimize the frustrations and keep the parking lot safe for everyone.

Guidelines:

- When double parked or stopping beside a yellow curb you <u>MUST</u> stay in your vehicle so you *can move* it if the person you are blocking needs to exit the lot. Many times we have Staff that need to get to meetings outside of our school.
- Do not block an open parking space.
- It is imperative that we leave a <u>clear path</u> through the middle of the lot so traffic can keep moving.
- If you get to the flagpole and your child has not arrived yet, continue to circle the lot until they do.
- Do not park at the entrance that funnels traffic into and out of the lot as it blocks traffic flow.
- Use the perimeter sidewalks to walk to the overflow lot rather than weaving in and out of the cars.
- Travel through the parking lot at idle speed.
- Please turn your vehicle off while waiting/parking. We are an idle free zone!
- Our parking lot is fairly small for the population of our school and during drop off and pick can be quite congested! If you are driving a larger vehicle or towing a trailer, please consider parking on one of the many side streets and walking to the school to pick up your child/children.
- Please <u>OBEY</u> all legal street signs around the school including bus stops and municipal issued no parking signs.

GRADE 8 TRANSFER PERIOD INFORMATION 2023/24

FOR PARENTS OF GRADE 7 STUDENTS

OVERVIEW

To provide an optimal learning environment for all students, the Maple Ridge - Pitt Meadows School District No. 42 (SD42) must manage enrolment across all schools, ensuring that enrolment numbers match building capacity.

"Where space and facility is determined to be available," the school district has an open boundary policy that allows flexibility in choice regarding which secondary school students may attend (School Act section 74.1 Section 6). Due to increasing enrolment in recent years, however, the majority of students are assigned to their catchment school. All our high schools meet the needs of all learners.

GRADE 8 REGISTRATION PROCEDURES

ONLINE REGISTRATION



The Grade 8 Transfer Period opens at **12:00 noon** on **Thursday, February 2, 2023**. All Grade 8 transfers/new to district registrations are done through the *Parent Portal*. If you are new to the school district, you will need to create a *Parent Portal* account before registering.



IN-DISTRICT STUDENTS

Families with children currently enrolled in a Maple Ridge – Pitt Meadows School District (SD42) elementary school should submit an *Existing Student Transfer Request* in the Grade 8 Transfer Period.

OUT OF DISTRICT STUDENTS

Families with children currently enrolled in an elementary school outside of the Maple Ridge – Pitt Meadows School District (SD42) should submit a *New Student Registration* in the Grade 8 Transfer Period.

DETERMINING CATCHMENT SCHOOL

The registration form will automatically populate with your child's secondary catchment school based on the residential address on file with your child's elementary school.

New development areas may not show accurate results. Please confirm with your child's elementary school if necessary.

You can also find your child's secondary catchment school using the school locator tool at



If the address you register on the portal does not match what is on file, proof of change of address will be required. Rental agreements are not accepted as proof of address.

ACCEPTANCE CRITERIA

The size of the school facility may limit the number of out-of-catchment registrations that can be accommodated. The school district will accommodate **catchment registrations first**, then attempt to accommodate **sibling out-of-catchment registrations**. Sibling placement cannot be guaranteed, however. Our acceptance criteria are as follows:

- 1. In-catchment area students who, in the previous year, attended the school;
- 2. In-catchment area students who, in the previous year, were placed by the district in a different school due to a lack of space
- 3. Siblings of in-catchment area students (grades 8 to 11);
- 4. New in-catchment area students;
- 5. Siblings of out-of-catchment area students enroled in the school (grades 8 to 11);
- 6. Out-of-catchment area students currently attending an SD42 school;
- 7. Out-of-district students currently attending an SD42 school.

ONLINE REGISTRATION DEADLINE



Deadline for completing a request for the Grade 8 Transfer Period is **February 17, 2023**. If you do not register by the online registration deadline, you will need to complete a request under the *Enrolment Requests – New; Transfer; Withdraw (2023/2024)* school year.

PLACEMENT NOTIFICATION



Parents will be notified by email before spring break about their child's assigned school.

TRANSFERS AFTER DEADLINE



Movement between schools after the school placements have been finalized will require a transfer request submitted on the Parent Portal under the Enrolment Requests-New; Transfer; Withdraw (2023/2024) school year.



The ability to transfer will be limited by building space and available staffing. See Student Transfer Guidelines.



A review of transfer requests will be completed before the Grade 7 orientation date in May. Individual meetings and/or visits will occur after placement.
