

## WILD & IMMERSIVE OUTDOOR NATURE PROGRAM (GR. K-7)

The Maple Ridge - Pitt Meadows School District has partnered with the University of British Columbia to offer this engaging, nature-focused afterschool program. Activities will take place mostly outdoors, so please make sure your child is dressed appropriately for the weather.

March 4: Beaks & Feathers: Spread your wings! Students will learn skills to identify local bird species by sight and sound while exploring their natural habitats and learning about bird's life cycles. Students will also determine what their own wingspan would be if they were a bird, learn how and what birds eat, and create bird "snacks" that they can use to attract birds to their own garden.

March 11: Geology Rocks: Dig deep into the geology and explore the landscape of this region! Students will take part in hands-on activities revolving around rocks and glaciation. From the last glaciation, they will investigate the clues left behind, and they will learn about their values and relevance, glacial movement, and volcanoes.

April 1: Wayfinder in the woods: Which way is North?

Can you find your way outdoors? Learn how to use a compass, read a map, and explore the great outdoors.
