What is Black Excellence <u>Day?</u>

As a lead up to Black History Month, Black Excellence Day is a day to rejoice Black history and learn about Black stories, Black art and Black people, and a day to stand in solidarity by wearing black. Black Excellence Day was created by Ninandotoo Society and takes place on January 13th, 2023 at the schools, but is actually on January 15th each year. January 15th is in honour of the great civil rights leader, Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. He was born January 15, 1929. The term 'Black Excellence' was born out of the civil rights movement in the 1960s.
