# School Opening Day 2024/25 Tuesday, September 3th from 12:30pm-2:20pm is the first day back for students going into Gr. 1 through 7

On the first day back to school, students return to their previous classroom teacher. In classes where the existing teacher is no longer at our school, we will have another replacement. New students in Grades 1 to 7 need to report to the table at the front of the school where they will be assigned to an age appropriate classroom for the week. Students come for attendance, and receive important information.

We need an accurate count for our enrollment, organization, and staffing. Please let us know if your child will not be present that day. For several reasons, we may not be able to organize students into "final" classes until Monday of the following week. Many factors make it more challenging to fine tune class composition, and we may require extra time.

New Kindergarten students will receive a letter of instruction via email regarding their first day of school and gradual entry.
