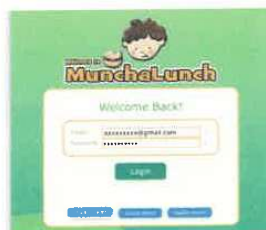

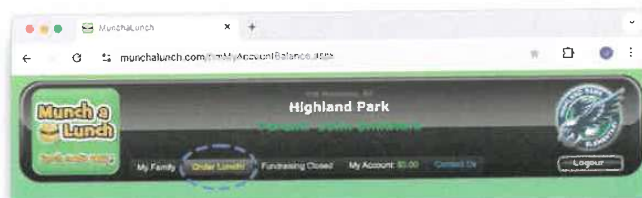
STEP 1
