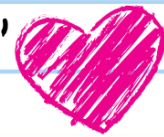

School supplies will be purchased by the school. The fee for supplies next year is \$55. Money will be collected in September.

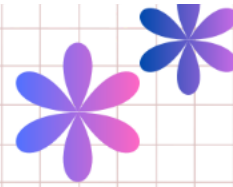
First Week of School
