### STUDENT LEARNING SURVEYS

The Provincial Learning Survey is unique in its scope, size and usefulness to schools. It gathers information from parents, teachers and students on topics related to school environment, safety, and achievement. The information is used for planning in individual schools and provides a district and provincial perspective.

**The Learning Survey is available to parents of all children in grades 4 and 7, February 1 -April 3.** The survey is also administered to students in grades 4 and 7, and all school staff. We encourage parents to participate in this survey, as the results are important in identifying and celebrating current strengths, as well as determining where the school needs to focus improvement. The surveys contain standard questions for the Province – in addition, questions from the school and/or district that focus on local conditions or issues may be included. The survey can be completed electronically and can be accessed on the Internet at www.bced.gov.bc.ca/sat\_survey/access.htm Please scroll down to the box at the bottom on the right. Follow the box identified as *Direct Access (no logon number required)*. Scroll to district 42 Maple Ridge/Pitt Meadows and then scroll to Maple Ridge Elementary.

All responses are anonymous and confidential. The surveys can be completed any time before April 3. We look forward to your input!
