



This fantastic new opportunity provides us with close proximity to a variety of outdoor programming options which will make the Summer a blast for your child/ren). Parenta please note that due to COVID-19 restrictions and room capacities to physically distance there are no waiting areas in the Heritage Hall facility during the Pitt Troopers program.

The facility is closed to gathering and parents will not be permitted in the program area. Please make sure to factor this in when you register your child. Sign in and sign out will take place at the Heritage Hall rear side entry doors, located next to the parking lot area. We will have a sign in table and City signage to make us easily visible. All of our Day camps have been specially programmed to offer as much outdoor activity as possible. While the program finds itself inside, staff will coordinate the fun with physical distancing in mind. Play and craft stations will
