HALLOWEEN

As Halloween approaches, we would like to remind students and families to please be thoughtful and inclusive when selecting a costume being worn at school. The following two guidelines have been provided by our school district:

- Be kind and consider the school community. Costumes that could be offensive or perpetuate the stereotype of someone's gender identity, culture, race, religion, age, or disability must not be worn.
- **Be thoughtful and safe**. Costumes that depict violence, alcohol or drugs are not appropriate. Similarly, replica weapons (e.g. guns, knives, etc.) must not be brought to school.



Due to the current provincial health and safety

measures, we ask students and families to refrain from bringing homemade food items to school to share with staff and students. Only commercially prepared and packaged foods (in the original unopened box/package) can be accepted at this time and should be given to the classroom teacher for distribution.

If your child requires individual photo retakes, they will be taking place on Tuesday October 26th. There is no sign up this year, all that is required is to fill in your child's Express Proof card and send it back to the school on the day of. Please include the reason you would like the photo retaken OR send a note with your child so the photographer knows what you would like done differently.

Fever (above 38°C)	If yes to 1 or more of these symptoms:
Chills	Stay home. Contact a health care provider or call 8-1-1 about your

Difficulty breathing	
Loss of sense of smell or taste	
OTHER SYMPTOMS	WHAT TO DO
Sore throat	If yes to 1 symptom:
Loss of appetite	Stay home until you feel better.

Extreme fatigue or tiredness	Stay home for 24 hours. If symptoms don't get better or get worse,

INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL:	WHAT TO DO
Have you returned from travel outside Canada in the last 14 days?	If yes: Fully vaccinated students, staff and other adults who have travelled outside of Canada may qualify for the fully vaccinated traveller exemption. Students, staff and other adults who are not fully vaccinated and have travelled outside of Canada CANNOT attend school for 14 days after arrival, as part of federal requirements.
CLOSE CONTACT	WHAT TO DO
Have you been notified by public health that you are a close contact of a person	If yes: Follow the instructions provided by Public Health.

You can also check your symptoms with the K-12 Health Check or the BC Self-Assessment Tool.

Call 8-1-1 with any questions about symptoms of illness. If you have severe symptoms, like difficulty breathing (struggling to breathe or you can only speak single words) or chest pain, call 9-1-1 or go to the nearest Emergency Department.
