# Course Planning "I'm going into Grade 9!"

- Students in grade 9 and 10 at MRSS must take 8 courses within the timetable
- Students may take more than 8 courses by taking a course in Block I (outside the regular timetable)
- You may not take this morning class in order to have a free block

### **MRSS Course Requirements**

There are some courses that you MUST take in your grade 9/10 year .....

#### **Core Courses**

- 1. English 9/10
- 2. Social Studies 9 / 10 or Sciences Humaines 9 / 10
- 3. PE 9 / 10 or Education Physique 9 / 10
- 4. Gr 9's Math 9Gr 10's FMP 10 / Foundations 10 / WPM 10
- 5. Science 9 / 10
- 6. English track MAY take French 9 or an Intro language (Intro German/Japanese/Spanish 11) if university bound or for interest Immersion students will take Francais Langue 9 / 10

#### **Elective Courses**

You may select 2-3 courses of your own choosing! These are called ELECTIVES!

- To repeat.... a second language is not required for graduation but may be required for post secondary.
- UBC regular language 11 credit / SFU Beg. Language 11 Credit. This may be one of your electives.
- $_{\circ}$  French Immersion students in grade 9/10 must select one French Immersion elective.
- A support class counts as one of these electives.

#### **Elective Choices**

 Talk to older peers, teachers, counsellors if you are having trouble making a decision.

 You may take courses that end in a 9, 10 or 11 (languages only)! You can read about all the electives on the school webpage! There are also promo videos!



### **Math Program**

#### FOR GRADE 10'S

There are three choices for Math next year.

Your teacher will make a recommendation and then you must sit down with your parents to decide what you are going to do. This will have an impact on future decisions.

### **Math Program**

#### **Math 9 / FMP 10**

- Generally, for students who are meeting the expectations of Math 8 / 9
- Foundations of Math 10 (recommendation of Math 9 teacher)

### **Workplace Math 10**

- Generally, for students who need more support with the Math curriculum
- Speak to your math teacher if you are concerned about your current math achievement

- #10 is an extra elective if you are planning to take an I block class (outside of the timetable)
- Remember to include your support block as one of these electives if you currently have one in grade 8 or 9.
