
- English 9 / Grade 10: Composition 10 / Creative Writing 10 / New Media 10

- 6. English track MAY take French 9/10 or an Intro language (Intro German/Japanese/Spanish 11) if university bound or for interest. A language course is NOT required for Grad. French Immersion students take Francais Langue 9 / 10

## Elective Courses

- You may select 2-3 courses of your own choosing! These are called ELECTIVES!
- To repeat.... a second language is not required for graduation but may be required for post secondary.
- UBC regular language 11 credit / SFU Beg. Language 11 Credit. This may be one of your electives.
- French Immersion students in grade 9/10 must select one French Immersion elective.
- A support class counts as one of these electives.
- Talk to older peers, teachers, counsellors if you are having trouble making a decision.
