Welcome

Welcome to the *Maple Ridge - Pitt Meadows School District (SD42)*. We are proud to be one of BC's most innovative school districts and make it our mission to ensure that all our learners feel valued and reach their full potential.

Registration process

Registering your child for kindergarten is a big step, but it doesn't have to be a difficult one. With our easy new online registration process, you can register your child from the comfort of your own home.

Review the registration steps below to ensure you are ready for the big day. Complete steps 1-4 before registration to save time.

STEP 1: OPEN A PARENT PORTAL ACCOUNT

You must open an *SD42 Parent Portal* account to access registration. If possible, complete this step well before registration day at <http://parents.sd42.ca>

STEP 2: FIND YOUR REGISTRATION DATE, CHOICE, GENERAL) to find your registration phase.

STEP 3: REVIEW OUR REGISTRATION FORM
Review a copy of our online registration form before registration day at <http://parents.sd42.ca>

STEP 4: REVIEW ACCEPTANCE CRITERIA
The order in which we place our new kindergarteners is determined by our *Acceptance Criteria*. Review these on page 3 of this brochure.

STEP 5: REGISTER
Register your child at <http://parents.sd42.ca>

STEP 6: PROVIDE SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS
Once you receive email notification of your child's tentative placement, you must bring supporting documents to that school. See *page 3 of this brochure*.



REGISTRATION PHASES

Registration opens at noon on the first day of each registration phase and closes at midnight of that registration phase's last day.

We will advise you of your child's tentative placement by email and will ask you at that time to bring all supporting documentation to your child's school. See acceptance criteria 1-5.

JAN 4 to JAN 10
SIBLING REGISTRATION

SIBLING REGISTRATION (for general and choice programs) is open for siblings of students already attending the desired elementary school (currently in grades K-6). See *acceptance criteria 1 on page 3*.

LATE REGISTRATION

LATE REGISTRATION phase is for parents who missed previous registration phases.



SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION

All students registering for kindergarten must be 5 years old on or before **December 31, 2018**.

Parents must provide **ONE** of the following documents for their child for verification:

Birth certificate, passport, immigration documents, Nexus pass

Every parent registering a child must show proof of BC residency with **TWO** of the following:

- BC driver's license
- BC identification
- Mortgage document or rental/lease agreement
- Municipal/utility tax bill
- Medical Services Plan card
- Immigration Canada documents
- Proof of employment



ACCEPTANCE CRITERIA

The following criteria will be used to determine order of placement of students:

1. Siblings of students already attending desired elementary school (currently in grades K-6)
2. IN catchment (proof of residence required*)
3. IN catchment daycare (proof of daycare in catchment required*)
4. OUT of catchment without siblings
5. OUT of district

*Parents must present documentation to the school once notified of tentative placement. See checklist on the back to find your submission deadline. If you miss your deadline, your child's school assignment will be cancelled and you will have to re-apply.

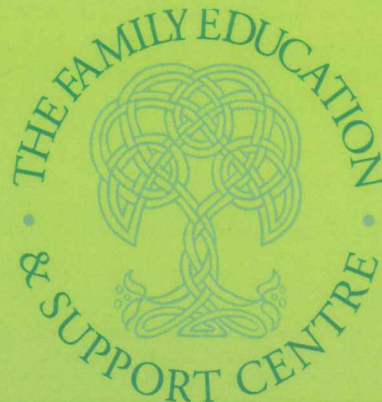

Price: \$90 for 1 parent and 1 child (\$25 for each additional parent of child)

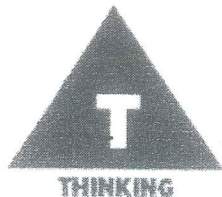

The Redesigned Curriculum at Pitt Meadows Elementary

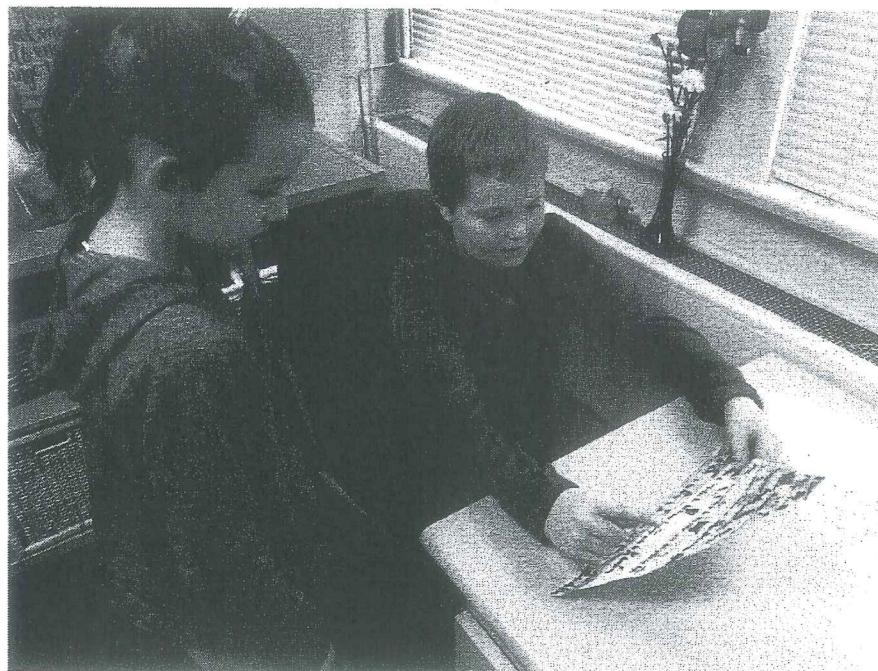
THINKING COMPETENCY



The thinking competency encompasses the knowledge, skills and processes we associate with intellectual development. It is through their competency as thinkers that students take subject-specific concepts and content and transform them into a new understanding. Thinking competence includes specific thinking skills as well as habits of mind, and awareness of thinking about thinking.

This student uses a pyramid structure to represent the key ideas in a novel. He explains that this way of showing his thinking about a book encourages him to read it more carefully so that he can find specific information.



Core Competencies: What are they and why are they in the new curriculum?

The new curriculum centres around the following three core competency areas: communication, personal and social, thinking. They are sets of intellectual, personal, and social and emotional proficiencies that all students need to develop in order to engage in deep learning and life-long learning. Competencies are evident in every area of learning and in every grade, and come into play when students become actively engaged in their learning. During the school year, students will have an opportunity to self-assess their proficiencies in these core competencies.
