Kindergarten Registration

Parents will see the information below when they click on Kindergarten Registration – SIBLING PHASE under Announcements and Events. Only parents who currently have a sibling attending the desired first choice school (currently in Gr K-6) and linked to their account are eligible to register during this phase.

Please note: Sibling Registration starts on Thursday, January 4th before school has started again.

Sibling Registration

Registration for this phase begins at noon on January 4, 2018 and closes at 11:59 pm on January 10, 2018. All students registering for kindergarten must be five years of age on or before December 31, 2018. (Born in 2013) During winter break, computers and/or assistance will be available at the District Education Office, 22225 Brown Avenue, Maple Ridge.

Once the timer at the bottom of this page counts down to zero, a button will appear to begin sibling kindergarten registration. (You may have to refresh the page to see this).

Kindergarten registration in the Sibling Phase is open for all students across School District 42 that already have a sibling attending the desired first choice school (currently in Gr K-6). The child <u>already attending school</u> must be linked to your account in order to register during this phase. The child you are registering for kindergarten <u>will not be linked</u> to your account until s/he has been placed at a school and supporting documentation has been provided to the school. Kindergarten students will automatically be linked to your account once documentation has been processed.

PLEASE NOTE: All registrations are date and time-stamped once you <u>start</u> the kindergarten registration form. There is no need to rush through the registration process. Please ensure all sections are completed <u>fully</u> and <u>accurately</u>.

Once you submit your registration form, you will receive a confirmation email that your application has been **received**. If you do not receive this email within 24 hours, please contact the IT Services Help Desk at 604.466.6248. For general kindergarten inquiries, contact Lynne Lloyd at 604.466.6218.

Shortly after the registration period closes, you will receive another email advising where your child has been *tentatively* placed. You will then be required to take supporting documentation to that school office. The deadline to bring supporting documents to the school for the Sibling Phase is noon January 17, 2018. If supporting documentation is not provided by this deadline, your child's school assignment will be cancelled and you will have to reapply.

*If you are registering twins, please make a note of this in the comments section on the registration form. A registration form for each child must be completed.



We thank you in advance for your help in sharing kindness.




CHRISTMAS HAMPER SOCIETY BAKE SALE

Kindergarten Registration

SIBLING January 4-10, 2018 (Documentation to school by January 17) (Although schools are closed for the first 2 days of this registration period, support will be available at the DEO. Schools will be open for registration 3 days the following week.)

CHOICEJanuary 18-22, 2018(Documentation to school by January 31)

GENERAL February 1-8, 2018

(Documentation to school by February 28)

LATE

March 28-June 7, 2018 (Documentation to school 5 business days after confirmation of placement)

- All phases open at 12:00 noon and close at 11:59 pm.
- The SD42 website has been updated with these dates.
- Registration starts during Winter Break to allow adequate time for Grade 8 registration before Spring Break.
- Kindergarten pamphlets and posters will be distributed to schools within the next week or so.

Information on Grade 8 registration will be sent out shortly, but registration will start around mid-February. Parents will be advised of grade 8 placement after Spring Break.

Ministry of Education Sign your children up today for a \$1,200 B.C. Training and Education Savings Grant

British Columbians are encouraged to sign up for a \$1,200 grant for their children's post-secondary education and training.

To be eligible, the child applying must have been born in 2006 or later and must be at least six years of age when they apply. The child parents/guardians must both be residents of British Columbia.

Signing up for the grant is as easy as stopping in at your local financial institution and following these simple steps:

- 1. Bring social insurance number (SIN) cards for both the child and the parent/guardian.
- 2. Sign the child up as the beneficiary of a Registered Education Savings Plan.
- 3. Complete the application at your financial institution.
- 4. No additional contributions are required.
