### Counselling Corner

A great community resource for families raising a child 5 years and under is Ridge Meadows Child Development Centre RMCDC. They offer pediatric rehabilitation services for children who may need professional help by an occupational therapist, physiotherapy or speech and language pathologist. Some examples of possible issues they treat are:

- Speech issues, slurring, lisp, stutter
- Crayon/Pencil Grip difficulties
- Learning how to handle big emotions such as mad, sad, confusion, happiness

RMCDC offers speech therapy, physiotherapy (to assist with child mobility issues), and occupational therapy. The pediatric rehab therapists are all trained to work with preschool children and help them build these skills and be kindergarten ready!

- Kindergarten pamphlets and posters will be distributed to schools within the next week or so.

**Information on Grade 8 registration** will be sent out shortly, but registration will start around mid-February. Parents will be advised of grade 8 placement after Spring Break.

### **Ministry of Education**

#### **Sign your children up today for a \$1,200 B.C. Training and Education Savings Grant**

British Columbians are encouraged to sign up for a \$1,200 grant for their children's post-secondary education and training.

To be eligible, the child applying must have been born in 2006 or later and must be at least six years of age when they apply. The child parents/guardians must both be residents of British Columbia.

Signing up for the grant is as easy as stopping in at your local financial institution and following these simple steps:

1. Bring social insurance number (SIN) cards for both the child and the parent/guardian.
2. Sign the child up as the beneficiary of a Registered Education Savings Plan.
3. Complete the application at your financial institution.
4. No additional contributions are required.

#### Overview

To provide an optimal learning environment for all students, the Maple Ridge – Pitt Meadows School District No. 42 (SD42) must manage enrolment across all schools, ensuring that enrolment numbers match building capacity.

"Where space and facility is determined to be available," the school district has an open boundary policy that allows flexibility in choice regarding which secondary school students may attend (School Act section 74.1 Section 6). Due to increasing enrolment in recent years, however, the majority of students are assigned to their catchment school. All our high schools meet the needs of all learners

#### ONLINE REGISTRATION

Registration opens at 12 pm (noon) on **Thursday, February 15, 2018**. All Grade 8 registrations are done through the Parent Portal at <https://parents.sd42.ca>. Each registration is time-stamped at the moment the registration form is opened to begin the online registration process.

#### ONLINE REGISTRATION DEADLINE

Deadline for Grade 8 online registration is **12 pm (noon) on March 2, 2018**. If you do not register your child by the online registration deadline, you will need to complete a paper registration form at your child's catchment high school.

#### PLACEMENT NOTIFICATION

Parents will be notified by email after Spring Break about their child's assigned school.

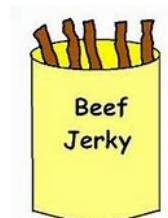

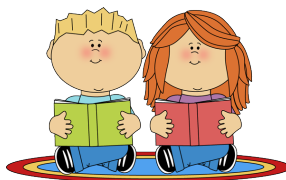
