
The Redesigned Curriculum at Pitt Meadows Elementary


INQUIRY LEARNING

Inquiry Learning is a process where students investigate and explore answers to questions. Inquiry questions provide a focus for learning the curricular content, encourage students to develop important skills when answering questions, and make learning more meaningful and relevant.

Inquiry questions provide a framework for teachers to more easily meet the needs of each student while allowing students to be more engaged in the content they are learning.

Students inquire into functions and relationships between angles. They take this learning into the "real world," noticing the prevalence of angles in everyday environments. As learning goes deeper, they recognize how angles are used in structures and even how they affect performance in sports.



Redesigned Curriculum: Know-Do-Understand

All areas of learning are based on a "Know-Do-Understand" model to support a concept-based, competency-driven approach to learning. In this model, three elements work together to support deeper learning: Content (Know), Curricular Competencies (Do), and Big Ideas (Understand). BC's new curriculum design enables a personalized, flexible and innovative approach at all levels of the education system. All areas of learning have been redesigned using this model.
