



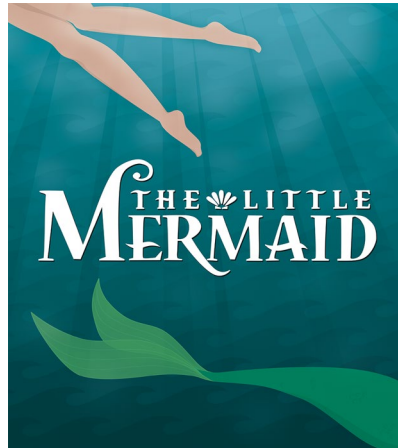

Registration Policy: Lottery

1. Wait until March 6th then go to www.theatryouthatre.com/lunchbox-theatre/
2. Find your school's name and click the Register Now button below. There will be no button before your scheduled registration window.
3. Fill out a separate registration form for each child you wish to register. You will receive a confirmation email that your registration was received. You will not be prompted to pay until after the registration window closes.
4. When registration closes, if more than 30 registrations have been received a randomized lottery will take place. If selected, you will be notified by email and given a link to pay for the program. If you were not selected, you will receive an email notifying you that you have been put on the waitlist.
