Super Six Practices

In these practices, we will work with the top 6 jumpers on their jumping technique. Remember, only the top 3 can represent PE in high jump, so this is but another step. In the week of May 23^{rd,} we will have jump-offs to determine the final top 3. To make it to the district finals, athletes must first qualify in the West Zone Eliminations, from which only the top 5 per category in the entire 10-school zone move on to the finals at Meadowridge. Luckily, PME hosts the West Zone Eliminations, so there is no need to travel that day.

Practices are as follows:

All the following practices are at 7:15-8:15am.

Grades 6/7s – Tuesdays*, beginning May 9th Grade 4/5s – Thursdays*, beginning May 11th

*There will be no practices during the week of May 15th because of the Grade 7 Victoria Trip.
