Grad Requirements

• Grade 10

- A Language Arts 10
- A Math 10
- Science 10
- PE 10
- Career Life Education 10
- A Fine Arts or ADST 10, 11 or 12 course

Grade 11

- * A Language Arts 11
- * A Math 11
- * A Science 11 or 12
- * A Social Studies 11 or 12

Grade 12

- * A Language Arts 12
- * Career Life Connections/Capstone 12

- A total of 80 credits, minimum 16 credits from grade 12 courses and 28 credits from elective courses
- As well, students must complete the following Provincial Assessments: Literacy 10, Numeracy 10, and Literacy 12



Grade 9 Required Courses

- English 9
- Social Studies 9
- Science 9
- Math 9
- PE 9
- Careers 9 (via Teams)
- 3 electives (students are required to take on Fine Arts course and one ADST course)

Students who select this will have a 'pod' for English 9 and Socials 9 coursework

Humanities 9 Pod

HUMANITIES 9 POD This course is a cross-curricular program that pods together English 9 and Social Studies 9. There is an emphasis on field trips, collaborative learning, team building, and cross-curricular studies. Students will intertwine literature and writing with concepts such as Canadian identity, colonialism, revolutions, and Indigenous perspectives.

Languages Options

• Do I need to take a language course?

No, but it may impact your ability to apply to specific universities directly from high school. Some universities require a language 11

If you are planning on continuing with languages in grade 10, it is strongly recommended you take a language 9

Do I need a language course?

No- direct entry to Douglas College, Kwantlen College, **UVic**

Yes- direct entry to SFU, UBC, UFV and Eastern Canada Universities

But-you may do a year at KPU, Douglas and transfer without a Language 11

How does course selection work?



Step 1: Counsellors complete course selection sessions with students Step 2: We collect course selection sheets from students

Step 3: We record the number of students who want each course

Step 4: We use these numbers to create the appropriate amount of blocks and build the schedule Step 5: Once the schedule is built, the computer loads students into courses based on requests. Often there are conflicts, so be sure to include alternates on your request form

Step 6: We go through every schedule individually to ensure graduation requirements are met
