# Student Fees & Locker Distribution (August 30th-September 1st)

All students who have paid their 2022-23 \$28 student fees are invited to come to school between August 30th and September 1st to select a locker. Student fees can be paid on the Parent Portal but may also be paid at school at the student's assigned day and time (cash or cheque are acceptable; credit and debit is not available at school).

Students should bring their own combination lock when claiming a locker. The school will not have locks for sale.

**Pro Tip:** students should take a photo of their locker number and lock combination when claiming their locker.

#### Tuesday, Aug. 30th (6:00pm) - Grade 12s (Senior Sunset BBQ)

- Students will come to the back of the school and check in prior to being brought into the school in small groups to select lockers near their TA.
- There will be a BBQ for all Grade 12 students who attend.

Wednesday, Aug. 31st (11:00am) – Grade 11s Wednesday, Aug. 31st (12:30pm) – Grade 10s Thursday, Sept. 1st (11:00am) – Grade 9s Thursday, Sept. 1st (12:30pm) – Grade 8s

• Students enter the foyer through the main door and check in prior to being brought into the school in small groups to select lockers near their TA.

If your child is not able to be here at their assigned time, they can choose a locker after school at the office during the first week of school.

### **Opening Day & Week Information**

NOTE - on the first day, not all students attend at the same time. Take a look at the schedule and determine by grade the time you need to arrive.

# Tuesday, September 6th, 2022

All students will attend their Teacher Advisory (TA) for one hour. Students will receive a copy of their class schedule, their planner and all the information required to get them ready for the first day of regular classes (Wednesday, September 7th).

ALL students will receive their class schedule in TA on Tuesday, September 6th. Please note that student schedules will be made available via MyClass at 8:00am on Wednesday, September 7th. Parents MyClass access will OPEN September 19th at 8:00am.

# **Course/Class Change Process**

What do I do if I need to change one of my courses?

Students can pick up a change request form during TA and drop it off at the counselling office. Updated schedules will be returned to TA boxes and distributed during morning TA. Counsellors are unavailable to meet for individual schedule changes during the first week of school.

# **Teacher Advisory**

Please note that unless a student has an administration approved work at home form, attendance during TA is required. TA starts at 8:30 and it is our expectation that students arrive on time. All students are required to maintain a daily plan using our paper planner. Students who consistently miss TA may be required to make up time by administration.

## **Reporting Student Absence**

All student absences must be excused by a parent or legal guardian or they will be recorded as "unexcused," and parents will be contacted by the autodialer. Absences reported to teachers may not be excused in our system, so be sure to contact the office in one of the following ways:

- Log into the parent portal and click the "Report Absence" tab. Select your child's name from the drop-down menu. Enter the date of the absence, or the date that the student will be arriving late or leaving early, as well as any other relevant details. \*\*This is the preferred method to report an absence\*\*
- Call the school directly at 604-463-2001
- Send a signed note with your student to the office prior to, or upon return from, an absence.
- Visit the office in person

#### Work-at-Home

Work at home applications will be available from the office for students in grades 11 and 12 during the first week of school. These applications are to be filled out and returned to administration for consideration. Only students that have demonstrated consistent work habits and achievement across all report cards last year will be considered.
