- **Tuesday** October 31st: Costume Day in the gym at lunch. Compete in the contest.

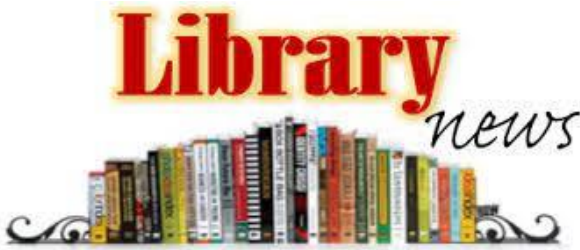
