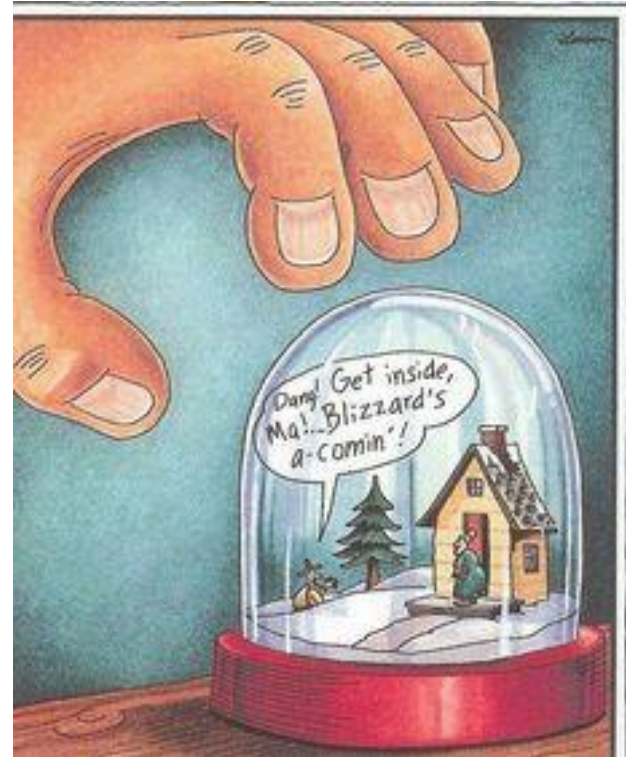

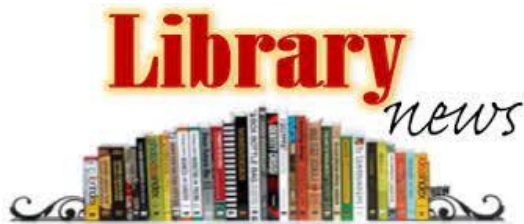
Grad photos December 4-8th
