Student Success - Ricky Liu

This past November, grade 12 student Ricky Liu participated in the 75th annual American Mathematics Competition (AMC) 12, which was administered by Mr. Radom. The AMC 12 is an international mathematics competition for highschool students, and it's designed to cultivate the mathematical capabilities of the next generation of problem-solvers. Approximately 38,500 students worldwide participated in it this year. Ricky scored in the global top 2.5%, thereby earning a Certificate of Distinction awarded by the Mathematical Association of America. In fact, this honour is the first-of-its-kind in SD42 and thus a great achievement for both Ricky and THSS!
