Out of a pool of more than 5,200 applicants, Emmy is one of the final 12 students selected as Loran Finalists for the class of 2024 from across Canada. Emmy has demonstrated the drive to step up in the face of challenges and positively impact the community.

We know that such promising young people have the power to change the future for the better—they just need a launchpad and opportunities to grow. This is precisely what the Loran Scholarship offers: an enrichment program of leadership development and diverse learning experiences that equip them to create positive change over the course of their lifetimes.

Good luck to Emmy as she travels to Toronto at the end of February. In Toronto Emmy will be in the final selection process to be chosen as a Loran Award winner. The Loran Award is a four-year leadership enrichment program consisting of summer work experiences, mentorship, scholar gatherings, an annual living stipend, and a tuition waiver at one of 25 university partners.

Parents and students are reminded to use the main doors as we will have students available to greet and answer any questions!


ThunderTech Robotics - Canadian Pacific Regionals in Victoria
