On the bulletin board across from the library, we have shared information about specific book challenges and bans. We are fortunate that students have the freedom to read a wide variety of books and perspectives in our school district. In Florida, for example, books which feature LGBTQ+ characters or antiracist messages have been removed from many libraries. Penguin Random House is currently engaged in a lawsuit to fight book bans in Iowa schools. Locally, the RCMP visited Chilliwack schools after parents complained about inappropriate material in school libraries; they found that no crime had been committed. Celebrate your freedom to read and check out a book that's banned elsewhere from our library or a public library!
