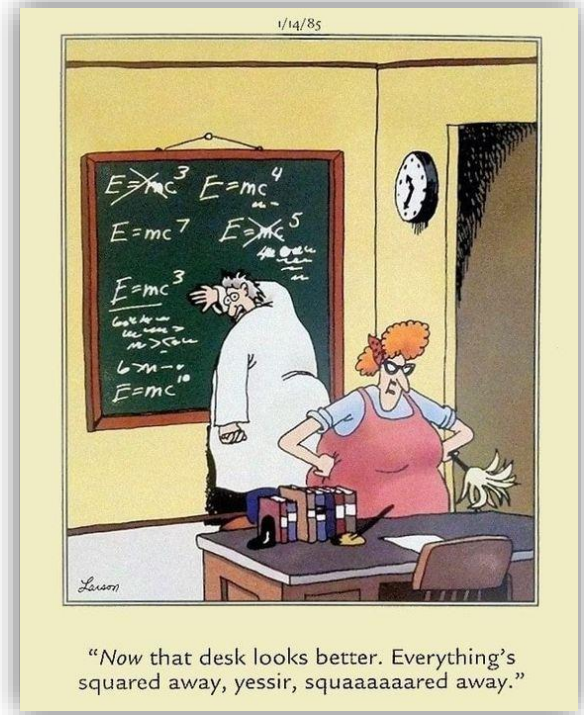

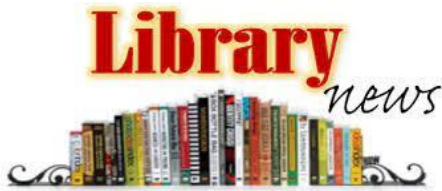
Grad ceremony fee balance is now due. The \$50 deposit should have been paid in December, and the balance of \$100 is due by April 30.
