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Valedictorian Criteria

- **A valedictorian is a person who represents what is best about the Thomas Haney graduating class.**
- **The Valedictorian needs to have four key qualities:**
 1. Flourished as a self-directed learning student who was able to direct learning in a meaningful and engaging manner
 2. Demonstrated leadership in the school and community
 3. Outstanding commitment to Thomas Haney Secondary
 4. Academic success (minimum B average based on all courses)

Valedictorian Process



Self-nominate – email or Teams message Mr. Rowell by **April 15th**

Graduating students who feel they meet the criteria can self-nominate to be valedictorian



Presentation to Grad Staff Committee - **April 29th (Y Block)**

All applicants need to be prepared to present three minutes of their speech and a paper copy to the committee as part of the selection process



Graduating students will vote on the candidates **May 13th**
