PROGRAM AT A GLANCE

Our *Elementary Summer Learning 2018 Program* will follow elements of the provincial curriculum. Emphasis in each of the two programs (grades K-3 and grades 4-6) will be on providing additional experiences in each of the grade areas. Textbooks and worksheets will be set aside as children engage in experiential learning and hands-on activities. Students will arrive just before 9:00 am, and attendance will be taken in the usual

Please note that you must be registered on the Parent Portal and have your child linked to your account before you can enrol him or her in the *Elementary Summer Learning* program. This part of the process can be done immediately. Get more information about Parent Portal registration from your child's school.

The Program Fee is \$50 (this consists of a \$30 refundable placeholder fee and \$20 for a take home project). You can pay the fee on the parent portal at the end of the registration process, or in person (by cash or cheque or debit)* at Riverside Centre no later than noon, **Friday May 25, 2018**. You will receive an email confirming your child's registration in the program **on Friday, June 15, 2018**. Your child's registration will not be official until you have received this confirmation. *Cheques made payable to SD42.
