A huge thank you to the PAC, and especially to outgoing long time president, Beeuwke Hulstra, whose youngest is now moving on to high school.

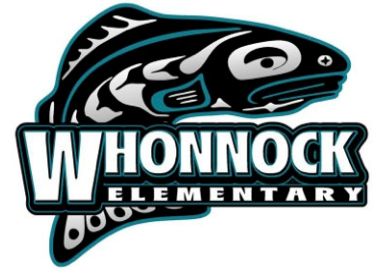

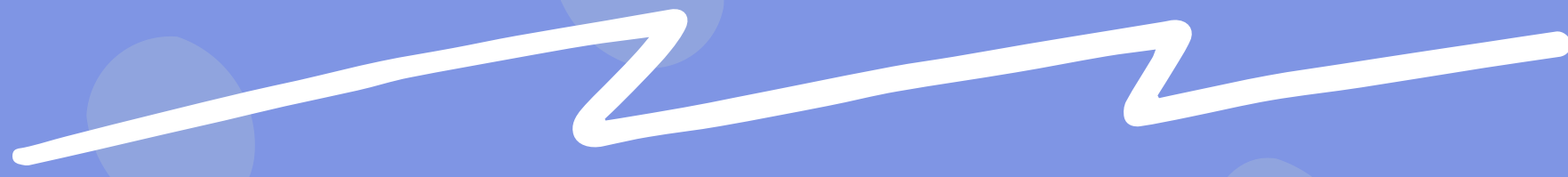
